1. Market on the Square -

- a. Stephanie gave a brief update on Market Day. We now boast 28 vendors for Market. This is 15 more since our last meeting. Public turn out has been very good and the only negative comments to date have come from concerns about electrical cords (city council), this has been addressed, and Porta-potty usage (this has been denied by the City).
